apple planted between the rows of your fruit trees. It is an easy fruit tree to grow. Another one is the guyabano. Oranges, camias, guavas, jackfruit and breadfruit should also be grown.

VI. CARE AND CULTIVATION

1. Root crops - Camote, gabi, ginger, onion, radish, etc.

Root crops are the easiest vegetables to cultivate. A light and loose soil is good. Cultivation may be deep but be careful and do not hurt the roots. Keep the top soil free from weeds. Loosen the soil deep enough so the roots will grow big. Mix some ashes with the soil.

2. Leaf crops - ilogbati, sangcang, colitis, manungay, talinum, etc.

Leaf crops require soil that is rich in nitrogen. Put plenty of well rotted manure in the soil. The plants need to be watered often. The cultivation should be shallow to keep the surface soil well pulverized. Do not cultivate deep to avoid cutting the roots.

3. Vine crops - ampalaya, seguidillas, cucumber, patola, citos, etc.

Vine crops require trellises for their support. Bamboo poles and branches of bushes are used in making simple trellises. The plants are best planted after the first rain in May. Squash beetles and other vine bugs are the great enemies of the young plants. Put tobacco

V. WHAT TO GROW IN THE GARDEN²

1. Plant either the lowland variety or the upland variety of gabi. Cmotes are good for large plots containing light soil. For a garden which is somewhat shady and moist, plant ginger. Plant radishes in the garden plot if you wish to raise the easiest vegetable to grow. If the soil is light and rich, plant onions.

2. Gangoong cuttings should be planted in a swampy site. Colitic grows in any kind of soil. Grow cuttings of marungay along the garden fence to save space. Alagbati should be provided with a low trellis. Plant talinum on the garden plot.

3. The easiest vine crop to grow is sitao. Provide bamboo branches for empalaya. Patola should be planted at the beginning of the rainy season. Construct a small trellis for cucumbers. Seguidillas should be provided with small poles or stakes.

4. Plant okra in your garden plot. Cadios should be planted along the garden fence. Plant cowpeas as a cover crop. Peanuts may be planted as a cover crop also. The soy bean is also a good cover crop.

5. If you have an orchard, plant a good variety of bananas. Do not be satisfied with the ordinary variety. Plant several good varieties. Papayas are good to fill the space along the fence of your orchard. Have some pine-

very effective.

(b) Sucking insects - plant lice, scale insects.

Sucking insects puncture the surface of the plant and obtain their food by sucking the juice. They are destroyed by external application of tobacco water or soap solution.

4. Pests and Diseases - Fungi, germs or microbes.

Leaf blights, mildews or rusts are due to parasitic fungi. They attack the leaves or stems of the plants and cause them to become spotted. Sometimes germs or microbes attack certain parts of the plants and cause them to die. The remedies are timely pruning and rotation of crops.

5. Weeds and Thieves -

Weeds rob the plants of their food by crowding the place where vegetables are planted. Cultivation and frequent cleaning are the best remedies. Weed seeds and plants should be burned to prevent future germination.

Another very destructive enemy of the garden is the human thief. Often he destroys more than he steals because he comes in the night and tramples on plants that he cannot see. But the worst enemy of the garden is "laziness" on the part of the gardener himself.

May we not resolve to have a garden in every home. This garden should not be one that has a few plants, but it should contain many plants. We should be able to get something from our garden every day to make our diet better. A

Plant vegetables which do well during the rainy season. Ridging may help plants from drowning. Except for windbreaks and shelter, plants are always at the mercy of the storm. Deaths from drought may be avoided by the use of a proper mulch.

2. Stray animals - Horses, carabao, cows, pigs, goats, sheep, and chickens.

A strong fence is necessary to prevent animals like horses, carabao, goats, and sheep from entering and destroying the garden. A strand or two of barbed wire nailed at the base of the fence will prevent the pigs from rooting under the fence. Chickens are prevented from entering the garden by making the height of the fence more than two meters high. An additional bamboo lattice work of about a meter high added to the top of the fence has been found to be very effective in keeping the chickens from flying over the fence into the garden.

3. (a) Biting insects - white grub, cabbage worms, cucumber beetles, cutworms, wireworms.

Biting insects either bite or chew their food. They are usually controlled by the application of dry lime, tobacco powder, or of ashes. White grubs may be controlled by deep plowing or digging and proper crop rotation. Cutworms usually attack newly transplanted seedlings. Putting circular cans or leaves around the seedlings is sometimes


