INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL:

- Read instructions carefully before filling out the register. This will avoid mistakes and omissions.
- Write clearly and legibly, preferably in ink.
- Do not write in columns indicated by letters.
- The register shall be prepared by the Leader of the Neighborhood Association in duplicate and certified by the President of the District Association, the original copy to be forwarded to the Bureau of Local Government, Manila, thru the city or municipal mayor concerned, and the duplicate shall be kept by the President of the District Association. Exception is made of columns 17 and 18, which shall be filled by the President of the District Association.
- The task of the survey is the family. By head of the family is meant anyone who maintains an independent household and by members of family is meant those who depend upon heads of families; such as, wives, children, etc.
- Orphan children and servants living with their families in the house rents or master should be considered belonging to an independent household, have a separate form.
- Do head is meant such relation, as grandmother, wife, etc., etc.
- Persons, such family living or board persons, are living in said house.

9. In the case of institutions, such as convents, monasteries or dormitories, all those living therein shall be considered as members of a family with the head of such convent, monastery or manager of the dormitory as head of the family.

10. In the case of hospitals, employees, such as nurses, attendants, etc., who do not maintain independent households but are quartered in the hospital shall be considered members of one family with the Director of the hospital as the head.

SPECIFIC:

- Enter paternal surname first, followed by maternal surname and given name.
- State relationship to head of family, as grandmother, wife, son, daughter, father, mother, brother, sister, servant, etc.
- Give age in completed years.
- Indicate sex by "M" for male and "F" for female.
- Indicate civil status by "S" for single, "M" for married, "W" for widowed, or "D" for divorced.
- Birthplace must include barrio or sitio in proper cases.
- Indicate citizenship.
- Race—

- State highest grade completed, as 2nd grade, 4th year (high school), 2nd year (college), etc.
- State whether able to read and write any dialect or language. Answer "Yes" or "No."
- Specify occupation, as carpenter, stenographer, barber, blacksmith, etc. Avoid the term "employee" or any such generic term. Persons engaged in household work or any kind of work not for profit or remuneration, should be considered employed as housekeeper, household helper, farm-laborer, etc. For those who have no present employment, state previous occupation.
- Give the nature of business of the employee, as bakery, distillery, cigar factory, importer and exporter, etc.
- 14-18. State salary or wage, as P1.50 under "daily" and P40.00 under "monthly."
19. Fill column with "Yes" or "No."
- 17-18. The columns "Power address" and "date of transfer to present address" are to be filled by the President of the District Association in the case of those residents who have come to live therein after the enforcement of this system.
19. State religion in full, as Catholic, Protestant, etc. The religion of minor children should be that of their parents. If the parents do not profess the same religion, the religion of the child shall be that reported by the head of the family.
20. In the column "remarks" relations should be made of all persons who are employed after the enforcement of this system, and such other pertinent facts.
