1. The following organization will be followed in the province of CAPIZ:

(a) The PROVINCE OF CAPIZ is divided into two sectors, viz., AKLAN SECTOR and ILAYAN SECTOR.

(b) The AKLAN SECTOR is divided into three Districts. The First District is composed of the towns of BANGA, CALIVO, NUMANCIA, LIZO, BALIMAO, and LIBACAO. The Second District is composed of the towns of BALETE, NEW WASHINGTON, ALTAVAS, and BAPAN. The third District is composed of the towns of IBAJAY, NAVAS, MAKATO, TANGALAN, and BURUANGA.

(c) The ILAYAN SECTOR is divided into four Districts, to be known as the 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th Districts. The 4th District is composed of the towns of TAPAZ, DUMALAG, DUMARAO, and DAO. The 5th District is composed of the towns of MAMBUSAO, SAPIAN, SIGMA, and IVISAN. The 6th District is composed of the towns of PANITAN, PONTEVEDRA, PANAY, and PILAR. The 7th District consists of the town of CAPIZ.

(d) The town of JAMINDAN is directly under the jurisdiction of the Military Commander of the Province of Capiz.

2. Each Sector will be under the command of a Sector Commander appointed by the Provincial Commander. Each District is under the command of a District Commander appointed by the Sector Commander subject to the approval of the Provincial Commander. Each Town will be under the command of a Town Officer appointed by the District Commander subject to approval of the Provincial Commander upon recommendation of the Sector Commander.

3. Each Sector Commander will organize a staff consisting of an Executive Officer, an Intelligence Officer, and an Adjutant. He is authorized a Headquarters Company to consist of not more than twenty enlisted men commanded by the Adjutant. The Executive Officer will act as a Supply Officer.

4. District Commanders will organize a similar staff as in par. 3.

5. Town Officers will have an Executive Officer. They will mobilize a MOBILE GROUP of at least ten men and are directly responsible for guerilla operations in their towns.

6. District Commanders will mobilize a Company within their District consisting of 110 EM and five officers. This Company will be named after its District, i.e. 5th Capiz Company. Its tactical disposition and use will be determined by the District Commander and will ordinarily be used to reinforce town forces.

7. District Commanders and Sector Commanders are responsible for the procurement of guns, ammunition, and other war material within their respective territories and supplying their subordinates with such.

8. Each officer is responsible for the supply of food for his own men. In addition thereto, Sector Commanders will cache enough food in security areas in the mountains to feed 200 men for two months and if possible, more. This is imperative and will be given the greatest attention.

9. Each Sector Commander will establish a base hospital at a point accessible to his whole command.

Subject: Filing of Income-Tax Returns.

GENERAL CIRCULAR NO. 74.

To all Provincial Treasurers:

1. This Office is in receipt of information to the effect that there are still persons liable to the payment of income tax who have not as yet rendered their returns for the year 1920 as required by the Income Tax Law. Inasmuch as the provincial treasurers are especially in a position to determine the persons liable to the income tax within their respective jurisdiction, as may be gleaned from the amount of real property they own, the amount and volume of their business as well as from other sources of information equally determinative of the income of a person whether natural or juridical, it is but just that this Office should look upon them for the discovery of all persons who maliciously or otherwise failed to comply with the law.

2. Provincial Treasurers are therefore requested to institute a campaign with a view to detecting all persons who have failed to file income tax returns for the year 1920 as well as for previous years. Any and all persons found delinquent in the filing of their income tax returns should be requested by letter to render a complete statement of their income from all sources as well as of any legal deduction and exemption to which they are entitled, and to explain why the penalties fixed by law should not be imposed for

The CO, of each MP Co. (Co. Hq-20; 4 platoons @ 40) will assigned an MP Platoon (Pat Hq-6; 4 sqds @ 8) to each rifle Bn, MP Bulletin No. 1, dated 27 March '43 and MP Circular No. 1, dated 31 March '43, this Headquarters, should be complied with.

GENERAL CIRCULAR NO. 67.

To All Provincial and Deputy Provincial Treasurers:

The attention of all Provincial and Deputy Provincial Treasurers is called to the Revised B.I.R. Forms Nos. 425-A, Income Tax Assessment Notice, 425, Income Tax Receipt, 518-A, Inheritance Tax Assessment Notice, and 518, Inheritance Tax Receipt, which, beginning January 1, 1921, will be used in the assessment and collection of income and inheritance taxes respectively. For the information and guidance of all concerned, the following instructions regarding the preparation and use of the aforementioned forms are hereby issued:

1. B.I.R. Form No. 425-A, Income Tax Assessment Notice: The Income Tax Assessment Notice shall be prepared by the Bureau of Internal Revenue in quadruplicate, the first three copies of which shall be sent to the Provincial Treasurer, who shall forward the first two copies to the Deputy Provincial Treasurer of the Municipality where the taxpayer resides. The Deputy Provincial Treasurer shall send to the taxpayer the original notice and retain the duplicate for his records.
2. B.I.R. Form No. 425, Income Tax Receipt: B.I.R. Form No. 425 being an accountable form shall be delivered to each Provincial Treasurer in the ordinary manner. Upon receipt of the amount stated in the Income Tax Assessment Notice (B.I.R. Form No. 425-A) duly prepared by the taxpayer and of any other amount to cover penalties or surcharges to which the taxpayer might have become liable, the Provincial Treasurer or Deputy Provincial Treasurer of the Municipality where the taxpayer resides shall write on the three copies of the receipt by inserting carbon papers between the original, duplicate and triplicate, the date of payment, total amount collected, etc., and signing the receipt the original shall be delivered to the taxpayer, the duplicate, forwarded to the Bureau of Internal Revenue with the monthly report of collections together with a duly executed abstract of collections on Provincial Form No. 10, and the triplicate, retained by the collecting officer for future reference.
3. Preparation of B.I.R. Form No. 425-A and 425 in the City of Manila: In the City of Manila, B.I.R. Form No. 425-A, Income Tax Assessment Notice, shall be executed in triplicate. The original shall be sent to the taxpayer, the duplicate, retained by the Income Tax Division for permanent file and the triplicate, sent to the Cashier to inform him of the amount of the tax due and payable by the taxpayer. B. I. R. Form No. 425 shall be executed in triplicate. The original shall be delivered to the taxpayer, the duplicate, sent to the Cashier for his records and the triplicate, retained by the Cashier for his records.
