I. SITUATION: You know the situation.

II. MISSION: This Battalion will perform the following mission:

1. On or about June 20, 1945 this Bn still continue minor operation against the enemy, in order to concentrate them into fewer garrison until the rainy season is well under-way.
2. Operation will consists mainly of the following:
 - (a) Sabotage all lines of communication including roads, bridges and railroad within the enemy occupied area.
 - (b) Blasting of trucks and tanks that transport troops from one garrison to another.
3. To support CP 3 and CP 5 in their operation to cover or contain enemy troops in isolated garrisons, or assist the landing of possible friendly forces by engineer methods.

III. TROOPS:

1. The HQ & HQ SERVICE CO. will continue to service the staff and letter companies and will be ready to reinforce any letter company as the situation demands.
2. "A" Company will cover the sector of Iloilo Province, bounded on the East by the Capiz Bdry, Bitagan-Pototan RR, then switches south west by the general line of the Iloilo-Sta Barbara RR, then Cabatuan-Janluay-Magapa Road, and then following up to the source of the Macapa River.
3. "B" Company will cover the Sector west of the Bdry of "A" Company up to Guinabel and Tubungan.
4. "C" Company will cover the Sector West of "B" Company up to Antique including Pandan.

X-1. Company Comdrs will move their troops in position upon receipt of this order. Contact with the Bn Comdrs of the Inf should be made immediately in the sector where they

are assigned to report for coordination purposes.

- X-2. All Company Comdrs should see to it that Security Discipline is observed.
- X-3. All operation should be carried on far from the security area and friendly installations.
- X-4. No Remote Control. Officers should be present in person in any operation.

IV. ADMINISTRATIVE:

1. Reports must reach this Hq not later than the 27th of each month.
2. All administrative matters are the function of this command.
3. Relay system should be arranged to facilitate sending of messages to this Hq.
4. Gr's should be mobile and contact men should alert in the old place until due notice has been made.
5. Training of men should be intensified to the highest combat efficiency.
6. Bn Finance Officer shall furnish regularly all Company Comdrs and authorized personnel considerable amount of Cash to be used for operation. The Bn Finance Officer will draw money from the division Finance Officer at such time as not to delay payment of salaries of this Hq.
7. All Company Comdrs should exert effort to recover Engineer equipment and supplies.

V. GENERAL:

1. In the absence of direct orders, Company Comdrs are given full authority to get in their best capacity and should always contact Infantry Units.
2. This Order rescinded Combat Order No. 1, issued by this Hq dated 8 April '43.

1. The enemy has a total strength estimated at 600 and 100 PC's stationed at the following places; as of 31 May 1943.

A. San Juan Area (Including Pululao, Bayang, Malantog, S San Pedro, Hantik, Telegrapho, Tubolan,) Japs - 250, PC's - 70.

B. Sibulan Area (Including Tarepas, Cabay Bari, Yago's Hill, Sibulan Cemetery, Villar, Boughongon, Erasa, Matarula, Tubuan, Iglagay, Cabanluan Hill, Balagaga) Japs - 200 PC's - 30.

C. The enemy has advance bases at

1. Grinsang-an (Crossing River, - Villavert) Japs - 50.

2. Lindero (Ilella - Antique Biry) and Ma-alan)
Japs - 2 trucks

3. Magarang Hill (Palmengon) Japs - 15.

D. Palmengon Area - Japs - 50.

2. Changes and more complete details regarding enemy disposition will be published from time to time.

II. OUR OWN TROOPS:-

1. The CP 3.3 and the CP 5 are in direct support.

III. MISSIONS:-

1. This company will:-

(a) support the CP 3.3 and the CP 5.

(b) Generally do sabotage work.

(c) Assist the CP 3 and the CP 503 in isolating the Japs garrisons from one another, or in driving them towards the General directions of the sea.

IV TROOP DISPOSITION:-

1. The 1st section will cover the area of Guinhal - Igtaras - San Benigno - Sibulan, inclusive. It will:-

- (a) Initially close the Guinalan - San Joaquin Road to motor driven enemy traffic and prepare plans and means to reconquer it if the enemy clears them away.
- (b) It shall lay heavy block on the Guinanga-an - Hantik road.
- (c) It shall lay mines on the roads mentioned in (b) above, as far as its supply facilities will permit.
- (d) It shall sabotage all enemy telephone lines, dumps, etc.
- (e) It shall ~~perform~~ shall perform such other duties as may be given it from time to time.
- (f) It will assist in the landing of friendly forces.

2. The second section will directly assist in the landing of friendly forces. It will cover the area from the line of the Sivanagan River (Inclusive) Tielas, Gudasang-an, Dae, Hantik, Ngana, Malandag, and San Jese.

- (a) Mine and block strategic points on the Mindoro - Guinanga-an - Hantik road.
- (b) Sabotage all enemy installations in Mindoro and Guinanga-an.
- (c) Do such other duties as may be assigned it from time to time.

3. The 3rd Section will cover the Patnongan - Bellison - San Jese - Odlong - Cubay - Villar - Bongbongan area. It will be assisted by the fourth section the operation in this area. Its duties are:-

- (a) To block and mine strategic places in the Bellison - Patnongan Roads, as far as its supply facilities will permit.
- (b) To block and mine the Villar - Bellison Road.
- (c) To deprive the enemy of the use of Bellison bridge.
- (d) To sabotage all enemy installations in Bongbongan and Villar.
- (e) To perform such other duties as may be assigned it from time to time.

4. The fourth section will cover the area north of the Cagayan River. Its duties will be:-

- (a) To provide for passage of friendly troops and vehicles as far as facilities will permit.
- (b) To assist the 3rd Section in its operations in the Bongbongan - Villar - Patnongan area.

1. To continue minor operation against the enemy, in order to concentrate them into fewer garrison.
2. Operation will consist mainly of the following:
 - a. Sabotage of all lines of communication including roads bridges and railroad within the enemy-occupied area.
 - b. Blasting of trucks and tanks that transport troops and supplies from garrison to another.

III. TROOPS:

1. The Hq & Hq Serv. 3. "B" Company will cover up the whole west of the area covered up by "A" Company and up to the boundary of Iloilo and Antique. It shall carry on its mission as it pertains thereto.

X-1. Company Comdrs will move their troops into position upon receipt of this order. Contact with Co Comdrs of Inf. Units should be made immediately in the Sector where they are assigned, for the purposes of coordination.

X-2. All Company Comdrs should see to it that Secrecy Discipline is observed.

X-3. Coined action should be carried on by "A" and "B" Com-

pany on Radio, Pavia, Sta Barbara, Capetuan and Reasin road.

- X-4. No remote control. Officers should be present in person in any operation.

IV. ADMINISTRATIVE:

1. All administrative matters are the function of this Command.
2. Reports should be submitted to this HQ in time as per Tickler issued by the S-1.
3. Training of men should be intensified to the highest combat efficiency when not on mission.
4. CP's should be mobile and men should always be left behind until due notice has been made.
5. Relay system should be arranged to facilitate sending of messages.
6. All Company Comdrs should exert efforts to recover all Engineer supplies and equipment wherever the direct representative of the G-4 is the field in getting those supplies.

V. GENERAL:

1. In the absence of direct orders from this HQ, blanket authority are given to Company Comdrs to act in the best of their capacity.
2. This Order rescinds Combat Order No. 2 dated 4 June '43, issued by this Command.
