25-31	Garrison training at Guisbanga-an, Outpost and guard duties and Patrol duties within the assigned areas.
Jan. '44	
1	CP remains unchanged at Guisbanga-an, Iauan-an. Men not on guard and outpost duty continue garrison training.
2	10 unarmed men under Lt Tupino sent out to procure palay, 3 unarmed men sent inside enemy territory to procure palay and remaining men not on outpost and guard duty continue garrison training.
3-6	Guisbanga-an - Garrison training and outpost and guard duties.
7	12 armed men under Lt Rendon sent on mission to Major Capinpin, remaining men continue garrison training and outpost and guard duty.
8	10 unarmed men under Lt Tupino sent out to procure palay, remaining men continue garrison training and outpost and guard duty.

25 Dec '44

- 16 Oct - Monday- Igeandel- All section proceeded to their respective post.
- 17-18 Oct - Tuesday-Wednesday- Igeandel- Usual Camp Duties.
- 19-21 Oct - Thursday-Friday-Saturday- Igeandel- Usual camp duties; Company assembled at Igesanding. Rest.
- 22 Oct - Sunday- Igensem- Encountered at Sibalem (Vege Hill)
- 23 Oct - Monday- Igensem- Encountered at Bori.
- 24-25 Oct - Tuesday-Wednesday- Igensem- Cleaning of rifles; Rest.
- 26-27 Oct - Thursday-Friday- Igensem- Cleaning of rifles carried one.
- 28-29 Oct - Saturday-Sunday- Igensem- Company moved to side then to Batson.
- 30-31 Oct - Monday-Tuesday- Company prepared for encounter; Usual sniping and guarding.
- 1 Nov - Wednesday-Catman Company prepared for encounter. Rest.
- 2-4 Nov - Attacked Japs Garrison in Sibalem, and Vege Hill resulting in the death of 10 Japs. Company prepared for encounter and return to base, remain to capture of same. Encounter at Barabana resulting to the death of Cpl. Abeng, F. Pvt. Nalaunan, M. and Pvt. Lubata, Presse.
- 5 Nov - Sunday- Catman- town of Sibalem was burned by the Engr. Squad. CO moved to Inasarayan.
- 6 Nov - Monday- Inasarayan- CO confers w/ Major Samalde in the 2d Hq. at again,
- 7 Nov - Tuesday- Inasarayan- CO moved to Catunganell- & Section were stationed in Begaret, Catungan 1V & 1II.
- 8 Nov - Wednesday-Catungan- Usual Camp duties.
- 9-Nov - Thursday-Catungan- 2d CO establish FCP at Begaret and stayed therest.
- 10-11 Nov - Friday-Saturday- Catungan- CO confers w/ Major Samalde & Co moved to Alayen. CO established thereat & all section posted at Tabeden and Indasden.
- 12-14 Nov - Sunday to Tuesday-Alayen- Usual camp duties. CO established RCP at Inabasan while the 2d CO inspected all section in the line. Sl MM fired in the High school. Usual camp duties.
- 15-23 Nov - Wed. to Thursday- Alayen to Inabasan. CO encountered around 10 Japs in Tabeden. CO w/ to their former post. Cleaning of rifles. Rest. Prepare for encounter. CO coordinate the raid while the 1st BN and 3rd BN launched the firing. Usual camp duties.
- 24-25 Nov - Usual troops disposition. Guarding and patrolling.
- 26-31 Nov - Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Inabasan Cleaning of rifles and usual camp duties.
- 1-6 Dec - Igabentay Usual camp duties.
- 7-12 Dec - Igabentay- Unchange.
- 13-21 Dec - Igabentay- Cleaning of rifles; rest; campaign for Alay; Capt Orbelose, report for duty.
- 22 Dec - Igabentay- CO inspect the company.
- 23-24 Dec - Igabentay- Preparing for Christmas gift.
- 25-Dec - Igabentay- CO inspect all section.
- 26-31 Dec - Igabentay- Cleaning of rifles; Campaign for Livestock; Cleaning of rifles; Usual guard duties; 2d CO went for inspection in the line; Section admin I squad for patrol.
