DIFFERENTIATE BETWEEN (1) HYDROCARBONS; (2) FATS AND WAXES; (3) GLYCOSIDES AND GLUCOSIDES; (4) TERPENES AND SESQUITERPENES; (5) PRIMARY AND SECONDARY ALCOHOLS; (6) ALDEHYDES AND KETONES; (7) VOLATILE AND FIXED OILS; (8) SATURATED AND UNSATURATED FATTY ACIDS; (9) RESINS AND OLEORESINS; (10) ESTERS AND ETHERS.

(1) Hydrocarbons may be differentiated from each other by the degree of saturation or unsaturation. On this basis they are classified as saturated (paraffin) or unsaturated (olefin, acetylene, etc.) hydrocarbons. The saturated or paraffin hydrocarbons have the general formula C_nH_{2n+2} while the unsaturated hydrocarbons have two or more hydrogen atoms less and belong to the general formula C_nH_{2n-2} , C_nH_{2n-6} , etc. Hydrocarbons may either be aliphatic or aromatic. Aliphatic hydrocarbons are those of the straight-chain type like paraffins. Aromatic hydrocarbons are those belonging to the type of benzene or its derivatives and substitution products, that is, there is the presence of a benzene ring in the nucleus of a molecule of the aromatic hydrocarbon.

(2) Fats differ essentially from waxes in being esters of fatty acids and a trichydric, low atomic alcohol (glycerol) while waxes are the esters of fatty acids and monohydric, high atomic alcohols.

(3) Glycosides are a class of organic compounds which when hydrolyzed, yield sugars and non-sugars called aglycons or aglycone or aglucons. They are differentiated from glucosides in that the latter yield glucose as the sugar.

(4) Terpenes are a class of hydrocarbons possessing the general formula $C_{10}H_{16}$, while sesquiterpenes have the formula $C_{15}H_{24}$. They are both unsaturated hydrocarbons but differ only in the number of C and H atoms. Sesquiterpenes have one and one-half of the formula of the terpenes.

(5) Primary alcohols are compounds containing the monovalent carbinol group $-CH_2OH$, while secondary alcohols are those which contain the divalent $=CHOH$ group. Primary alcohols on oxidation yield aldehydes, then acids while the secondary alcohols yield ketones.




Glucose, the dextrorotatory variety, or grape sugar or dextrose is assigned the following formula:

It is found together with fructose in grapes, figs, and other sweet fruit, in honey, and in the urine of diabetic patients. In combined state it is present in polysaccharides as sugar, starch and cellulose.

It may be obtained anhydrous or with one molecule of water. It is dextrorotatory in aqueous solution and exhibits mutarotation. It reacts as alcohol because of its five hydroxyl groups and as aldehyde and therefore as reducing agent due to its aldehydic grouping.

It is used in the manufacture of sweets and wine.

TENTATIVELY FROM A SMALL AMOUNT OF DRUG? NAME FIVE
PHILIPPINE PLANTS THAT YIELD VOLATILE OILS.

The different methods of obtaining volatile oils from plant materials are steam distillation, extraction by means of selective volatile solvents; enfleurage or extraction with non-volatile solvent with the aid of heat, and maceration.

Five official (U.S.P.XI) volatile oils are: oil of anise, oil of orange, oil of clove; oil of chenopodium; and oil of cinnamon.

Volatile oils can be estimated quantitatively from a small amount of drug by the use of an apparatus in which the drug is suspended by means of a cheese cloth bag in a flask with one-third full of water. The flask is covered with a cork with two holes: one for carrying away the steam, by means of a glass tubing

to an upright condenser which condenses the steam with the volatile oil into a portion of a graduated glass tubing, and the other hole is for the entrance of the excess water that has been condensed. The volatile oil which is usually lighter than water, is collected on top of the condensed water vapor in the graduated cylinder and can be easily read off.

Five Philippine plants yielding volatile oils are: "colchot" (*Citrus hystrix*); ilang-ilang (*Cananga odoratum*), lemon grass (*Andropogon citratus*), clumpak (*Michaelia chrysokalis*), and ginger (*Zingiber officinale*).
