REMARKS:

a) Some of the cases had to be referred to lower headquarters for investigations due to proximity of parties involved therein, the dispersion of the units over wide and difficult terrain, and the non-availability at times of some or all of the Officers of the Inspector General Section to attend to investigations, as the Section is further charged with the additional duty of tactical and training inspections and membership of or as details of Court Martial, etc. Enemy raids and friendly operations in certain areas hinder or delay investigations. Unit Commanders are ignorant of the legal requirements of investigations and lack of interest in their prerogative to look into cases of their erring personals.

b) Of the cases of misappropriation of Public Funds by DGM Agents and Finance Officers aforementioned, only that of Lt Romeo Bellone as far was referred to District No. Capt. Agapito Mastro, 2nd, DGM, TSD investigated this. It was sent back to CP-Dixie with the recommendation that it be investigated in accordance with Art. 71 AW. The Division Auditor has just received the money accountability of Lt Carlos de los Santos, 2D, 22 "G" and as soon as the report is received, appropriate examination of his accountability records which are irregular due to his apparent ignorance of accounting and some of his procurements fall into enemy hands. As a result of his apparent ignorance of keeping records also, Lt Japet de la Cruz, former DGM Agent, 76th Lance area, has been also given opportunity to fix them up. The Division Auditor also directed Lt P. Coville, FO, 2nd Bn, 76th Inf to exercise within 6 months the loan given to personnel, 2nd Bn, 76th Inf. Copies of the Report of Examination of accountabilities of above Officers were furnished District Finance Officer, TSD. Similar chance has been also accorded Capt Isabela Calanda, former FO, NMS to re-liquidate all her NMS, NMS as the liquidated vouchers received by him from all in NMS were lost during the enemy raid of Advanced CPN (Bn, NMS) in 25-26 Oct. 43. Capt Calanda is almost through and soon the Division Finance Officer will liquidate his accounts. Upon receipt of the liquidation report, appropriate action thereon can be determined.

c) DGM Agents being District personals, the case of Lt Bellone was referred to CP-Dixie. The other similar cases, however, have been looked into by the Division HQ, as above stated for obvious.

d) The Inspector General Section has taken cognizance of the above serious cases only. The less serious cases are held pending to give chance to reluctant aggrieved parties to come out in the open for fear of retaliation. Other serious cases are pending or being dropped either because the accused escaped to enemy occupied area, witnesses could not be dispensed with from operations presently, or Military Court has no jurisdiction following the precedent held in the case of PP vs. Lt Amancio Tambi, et al for Maydane. There are already about 400 minor cases terminated, all handled by this Section since the beginning to date. The accused thereof were either reprimanded, warned or admonished. The rest were dropped for lack of proof. Presently there are 60 minor cases pending investigation in addition to the above grave ones.

e) 1st Lt Romeo C. Bitching, Investigating Officer, JAGS72D, who was present in our conference in absence of the JAG was advised to submit similar report. As legal adviser of the Division Commander, the JAG has taken cognizance of some serious offenses referred to and received by him from lower headquarters, which have not been cleared through the Inspector General Section.
