1. According to the recommendation for release dated 29 Oct. '44 (attached), which the undersigned has submitted to the Division Commander, he recommended the release of the following prisoners:

2. In the supplementary report which was submitted on the same date, he likewise recommended the release of:

3. As may be seen in paragraph 1 hereof, Virginia Soliney has been recommended for immediate release.

4. The release of the abovementioned prisoners having been verbally approved by the COMINTD, a request for the issuance of the corresponding Special Orders for release was made to the CMB (attached).

5. On 5 November 44, at about 7:30 p.m., however, this Office has received from the Provincial Fiscal a complete list of "all Criminal Cases" filed with the Court of First Instance (attached), wherein it appears that the corresponding information has already been filed against said Virginia Soliney.

6. Considering the fact that the Civil Court has already taken cognizance of the matter, it will be a good policy to let justice follow its course.

7. Wherefore, it is suggested that Virginia Soliney be not ordered release from confinement until her case is definitely decided by the Court of First Instance.




