1. OUR FRONT LINE: No change.

2. LOCATION OF TROOPS:

- a. Enemy: In this sector the enemy has occupied and garrisoned the towns of Kabankalan, Binibagan, Isabela and Binigarin.
- b. Our troops: Troop location cannot be given as units are highly mobile.

3. ADJACENT UNITS: No change.

4. WEATHER: a. Sub-Sector "O", Rainy

b. Visibility: Clear

5. OUR OPERATIONS FOR THIS DAY:

1. Sub-Sector "O": See annex.

2. Sub-Sector "N": 10 Sept. '43, (Late reports) Petrolmen of "G" Co., stationed at Lupni, intercepted the Japs foraging patrol at 4:30 AM at Rd. Progress. Two Japs were killed. On same date at 12:00 mid-night, another group of snipers raided the Japs guards and patrol in Central Palau, resulting to 3 Japs casualties.

(a) 11 Sept. '43. Snipers of "U" Co., stationed at Lupni again ambushed the Japs foraging patrol at 4:30 AM at Rd. Progress. Casualty not verified. None on our side.

(b) A patrol composed of ten (10) riflemen, "M" Company raided the enemy's outpost at Kabankalan on the night of same date. The enemy retaliated with MG and Mortar fires. One hundred and eight (108) rounds of ammunition were expended during the whole operation. Casualty on the enemy's side under verification.

16 September '43:

(a) A patrol of Lt. S. Zebala, under Corp. Tablonia intercepted the Japs truck going Binibagan-and at 5:30 AM. At 17 Japs killed. Lt. Col. ... and two reported missing during the operation is already accounted.

(b) At exactly 0600 AM, on same date, the Japs in advance guard formation were intercepted by the out-patrol forces of "P" Co., from Kabankalan and Isabela at Binibagan, the action passed and about twenty Japs were accounted. Col. D to D.

RECAPITULATION OF THE REPORT PREPARED ON 15 SEPTEMBER 1943
CONCERNING THE COMBAT ACTIVITIES OF THE 1ST INFANTRY PLATOON. NO REPORT RECEIVED FROM THE 2ND PLATOON.

- (a) Coas. "F" and "G" on same date successively ambushed enemy batwoman Rihulbangan and Xaben along highway. Firing was heard 6:30 AM till 12:00 o'clock noon. No reports available yet.

RECAPITULATION OF THE REPORT PREPARED ON 15 SEPTEMBER 1943
CONCERNING THE COMBAT ACTIVITIES OF THE 1ST INFANTRY PLATOON. NO REPORT RECEIVED FROM THE 2ND PLATOON.

15 September '43:

- (a) At 0800 AM, after informing the commandant Lt. Mijares and 7 enlisted men with sidearms and machine TS-6 (Tompson Sub-Machine Gun) left their last assembly area and entered the town of Lubuklongat at 0810 AM, with a mission to capture, apprehend or kill well-known Japs spies and guides in their areas. Lt. Mijares and party reached their destination, but failed to find their target (Bodice) in residence. "Bodice" was absent, attempting during firefights to evade the capture, but was shot dead. The Japs fired wildly in all directions, no aim no mark. Withdrawal of the patrol from the town was successful. (Infantry S-3 Weekly Report, Sub-Sector "H")

V Weather: 13-16 Sept. '43 - Stormy, 17-19 Sept. '43-Bright with good
visibility, 20-23 Sept. '43-Bright, 24 Sept. '43-Bright with
passing showers on the afternoon, 25-27-Bright with good visi-
bility.
VI Our Operations:
(a) 13 Sept. '43-Capt. P. V. Ramee, Lt. Hijares and 11 E.M.
including Ricardo Nagbonia, a former Jap guide left CPA at 6:40
A.M. Their mission was to capture, apprehend or kill some
known Jap guides and spies. Capt. Ramee took Ricardo Nagbonia
with them in order to accomplish their mission. All members
of the party except Ricardo Nagbonia were armed with side arms
properly concealed and disguised as civilians. The party
arrived at Tagui, Kabankalan at 2:10 P.M. via Km. 106 Dancalan
Tubla Road, Tambu-an, Osab, Libas, Munob and Salong. The party
spent the night at Mr. Corliss Garde's house.
14 Sept. '43 Capt. Ramee and party went out to the Tagbu
in Tagal, but the mission was not accomplished because the
suspect has not showed up. They spent the night again at Mr.
Garde's place.
15 Sept. '43- The party left for the Tagbu at Calumpang,
Salong, where they met Mrs. Nidela General, a woman suspected
of having gone to Kabankalan the previous week. After apprehen-
sion and proper investigation she was released for lack of
evidence. The party returned and spent the night at Mr.
Garde's place.
16 Sept. '43- The party went out for the Tagbu at Camansi.
Kabankalan. Plans were made and perfected to kill Castilio Badioc,
alias Badioc, the No. 1 Jap guide, residing in the town of
Kabankalan. After supper, Lt. Hijares, Ricardo Nagbonia and 7
E.M. with the Thompson Sub-M.G. with them left assembly area
leaving Capt. Ramee and 3 E.M. in the assembly area. They en-
tered Kabankalan at 8:30 P.M. and reached the house of Badioc
at 9:00 P.M. Although the plan was to take Badioc alive if
possible, yet the situation demanded that he be shot to death. In
asmuch as he attempted to escape capture. Of the total of
22 rounds fired during this operation, 7 were directed at Badioc
with a range as close as 3 feet. The rest of the shots were
fired to divert the attention of the Japs who were about 50 yards
from Badioc house where the killing took place. Upon hearing the
firing of our men, the Japs started firing in the general direc-
tion of Badioc's house, which continued for almost an hour. The
Japs used up 8 trench mortar shells, about 100 rounds of their
27 and 30 Cal. rifles, and about 500 pounds of their 30 Cal. Ma-
chine Gun. Inspite of this firing which lasted until 11:00 P.M.
our men under the leadership of Lt. Hijares, were able to make
an orderly withdrawal along the banks of Kabankalan river, only
after firing had ceased, with the exception of Pfc. Andres Mon-
tan who swam across the river and reported at Calumpang at 12:00
P.M. 17 September '43, Hijares and party reported to Capt. Ramee
at the assembly area in Camansi at 9:30 A.M. where they slept
in the vicinity of the place until 6:00 A.M. of the next day.

17 Sept. '43- Ricardo Magbanua with two E.M., Romeo Juarez and Teodoro Olam were sent by Capt. Ramos on a mission of apprehending a reported Jap messenger to Bacold, Fernande Rivas by name, reported to be at Nahule-gang, Kabankalan. These men left Camansi at 7:00 A.M. The rest of the party under Capt. Ramos, with the exception of Lt. Mijares, who was taken sick, returned to CPA and arrived at 6:00 P.M. 17 Sept., all men and arms present and accounted for.

18 Sept. '43- Lt. M. Lopez, who was on a similar mission, Ricardo Magbanua and 2 E.M. with him arrived at CPA at 12:00 noon with Fernande Rivas, the suspected Jap messenger. This boy who is 15 years old after proper investigation was found to be innocent although he really entered Bacold, hit on a purely personal matter.

(b) Hq. and Hq. Service Company - 18 Sept. '43 moved to Hambagay from front line.

14-19 Sept. '43- Usual field duties.

(c) Combat Company-13-23 Sept. '43 - Usual front line duties.

(d) Hq. & Hq. Service Company - 20-27 Sept. '43-Lt. Q. Bandala with 4 riflemen patrolled along the coasts from Bucana Diet to Bulata.

(e) Combat Company - 24 Sept. '43 - A combat patrol lead by Licut. Tenerife was sent to Ma-eg and vicinity as security for the engineering boys, building obstacles.

VII Combat Efficiency: Satisfactory

VIII Result of our operation:

(a) No casualty on our side.

(b) One Jap guide Custodio Gabite alias Budice seriously wounded as verified by the S-2.

(c) One Jap guide by the name of Leopoldo Sifel was recently captured.

IX Miscellaneous:

- (a) Active campaign against Jap spies and guides.
(b) Active vigilance against any Japanese campaign towards the South.
