I. SANITARY CONDITION

1. The Company operates on its three (3) platoons, as three independent units, distinct and separate from each other. Each platoon has its own quarters, kitchen, toilet, mess, etc.
2. The kitchen and quarters are neat, clean and orderly - no flies. The odor of the toilets is faint - practically nil. They have even improvised mess tables. The greatest advantage of a small kitchen is that the men messing together could eat on time and the rice at least is better cooked.

II. INSTANTION IN RANKS

1. The officers and NCOs appeared contented with the camp life. They enjoyed it.
2. The NCOs have better and more clothes on as compared with the other units inspected. Cpt Cabrera and his staff collected some money together and purchased clothes for their needy men. This amount so expended was paid on the installment basis.

III. COURTESY AND DISCIPLINE

1. The company is well disciplined. As a matter of fact military atmosphere prevails in the camp. The Junior Officers and the NCOs manifested their courtesy and discipline, whether they are in the office, in the field or in the play ground. There is not one occasion, when an NCO was talking to his officer, or a junior officer talking to his senior officer or commanding officer, not in a military manner. As to courtesy and discipline, it is only Co. "C" of 2d "A" (NCO) that could enjoy its comparison.

IV. GENERAL COMMENT

1. The company is the only company as far inspected that has its own training schedule made by the CO to suit existing conditions.
2. The company has its own lecture and study hall, distinct and
