Subject: Instructions and Reminders

To : All Regimental Commanders, 720

1. All Regimental Commanders thru their G-1 and other staff officers must not forget to look after the welfare of all personnel under them. The following pointers are enumerated hereunder for guidance of staff officers concerned:

(a) To seek cooperation of the civil populace thru the civil government officials, the creation of certain organizations such as the WAC, WAC, RAC and other similar bodies which should aim to promote or enhance the morale of our soldiers.

(b) Ladies properly chaperoned may be invited to unit headquarters during Saturdays or Sundays to entertain and/or give inspirations to our men. During this period, a program may be staged and participated by soldiers and visitors, but dances are inadvisable.

(c) Holding contents in athletics and games should be held once a week, preferably on Sundays. Attention is invited to G-1 Bulletin No. 7 S. 1943.

(d) To encourage the soldiers to write letters to their home folk and friends but secrecy discipline must be observed as usual. The Army postal service, in coordination with the civil government postal service, will take care of the delivery to the addressee.

(c) Commanders, a list, for the protection of all concerned, provide all Enlisted Men a copy of the soldier's Service Record once he is reverted to inactive status or discharged from the service.

2. Any or all measures taken to enhance the morale of the soldiers in your respective organizations must be reported and described in all your 3-1 Periodic Reports, under its appropriate heading.

3. Do this immediately.

To : All Sector Commanders

1. A company of Military Police (MP) is created at an organic part of the 72d Division with HQ at CIG-Y. Its authorized strength is the same as the Infantry company.
2. The MP Commander is the Division Provost Marshal and his job, as Asst Provost Marshal.
3. In excess of 85% of the authorized strength as provided for in CIG letter dated 9 July 44 indexed by this HQ, on 25 August 44, you will immediately organize in your respective Sectors the following MP units:

- 1st MP Platoon to be organized with full strength at NERS
- 2nd MP Platoon to be organized with full strength at CWS
- 3rd MP Platoon to be organized with full strength at Eng & NERS

The HQ personnel will be organized by the Division Provost Marshal.

The Cos, NERS and ERS, will effect between themselves necessary arrangement in the organization of one MP Platoon for both, with station at Sub-sector Y.

4. Qualifications for MP enlisted personnel:
(a) At least Primary school Graduate and can speak fairly good English.

5. The MP company is tactically and administratively controlled and supervised by the MP Commander.

6. Advise this HQ as soon as your MP units are fully organized.
