SUBJECT: Regulations

TO ALL MUNICIPAL TREASURERS
AND MUNICIPAL PRESIDENTS
PROVINCE OF NEGROS OCCIDENTAL

For your information, guidance and strict compliance, I am transcribing hereunder General Memorandum Order No. 139, dated September 26, 1935, of the Honorable Secretary of Agriculture and Commerce, which reads as follows:

"By virtue of the Proclamation issued on Sept. 23, 1935, by His Excellency, the Governor-General, declaring under the provisions of Act No. 4198, the existence of an emergency due to a serious shortage of rice and the consequent inflation of the prices thereof, and designating the Bureau of Commerce as a relief organization, with power and authority to import rice, free of duty, in such quantities as may be necessary to relieve the situation, and to sell such rice without profit and in accordance with the provisions of Act No. 2668, this General Memorandum Order regulating the sale of rice to distressed individuals is hereby promulgated for the information and guidance of all concerned.

1. The Director of Commerce shall handle the sale of rice in Manila through the Manila Trading Center and Exchange and may assign for this purpose such personnel as may be necessary for the prompt and proper execution thereof.
2. In the provinces the Director of Commerce may delegate this work to the Provincial Treasurers thereof with the proper authorization of the Honorable, the Secretary of the Interior.
3. Sales shall be made on strictly cash basis and at prices to be determined by the Director of Commerce and approved by the Secretary of Agriculture and Commerce.
