Subject: 20% Government Share on Palay or Corn


To : CO, 72nd Division

1. A true copy of the communication of Acting Municipal Mayor Policarpo Valera dated 28 June 1944 is forwarded herewith for your perusal and information.

2. It shall be noted from said communication that the Civil Government shall continue to collect directly the 20% Government share. This is not in line with our previous understanding with the Island Governor whereby the Army could collect directly the 15% agreed upon as its share out of this 20%.

3. Our area is badly in need of rice. It is therefore requested that the Island Governor be so duly informed as to enable the Army collect its share.

4. It is requested further that when the Army shall have been authorized to get its share, the undersigned as officer in-charge of this area be authorized to act as representative of the Division Quartermaster to collect directly the share of the Army from the harvest of such planters whose fields are located at "sitios" Kumaliskis and Hignaya-an. These steps will obviously abbreviate handling and hauling expenses from said "sitios" to the storehouse of the Division Quartermaster and from the said storehouse to the offices of the Division Finance Officer, AC of S, G-1 and Adjutant General in this area. The undersigned shall take care of the distribution of whatever food supply is collected to the different Sections at CPG-X-1, and submission of necessary reports.

1. 3/4 of the 20% Government share could be taken by Army procurement officers or agents on the spot where collected. This is our agreement with the Island Governor. The remaining 50% is open for procurement by Army procurement officers or agents. Direct the Division Quartermaster to be present during harvest, or he may send any of his representatives.

2. The Island Governor has been requested by the DOTD to discontinue collecting the 20%, on any taxes in kind. Until further orders, however, Par 1 above will be followed.
