Subject: Civilians Refusal to Accept Military Script and Government
Notes; Prefer to Accept Enemy Notes
To : CG, 7TH Division

1. It has been reliably reported and verified by the personnel of this Office that there are civilians who are refusing to accept either Military script or Government notes. These civilians prefer to accept Japanese notes.

2. When our soldiers buy commodities, fish etc from these civilians, these civilians will first find out what money does our soldiers have. If they find that the money of our soldier is Military script or Government notes they (civilians) sell the commodities to them in a high price and sometimes refuse to sell on the pretext that they have no change. However, if these civilians found out that the money of our soldiers are Japanese notes, they sell them the commodities at a lower cost and facilitate the change. In other words these civilians prefer the Japanese money than the Military script or Government notes. This action of the civilians is not only prejudicial to the cause but also encourages the use of Japanese money and discourages the use of our money. This act is definitely hostile to our cause. This is interpreted as siding the enemy.

3. Warning is hereby addressed to all Units to arrest these civilians who refused to accept our money. Bring them to the nearest outpost for investigation. Any person refuses to accept our money is considered our enemy and would be treated as such.
