MEDICINES	DISEASES	DOSES
SULFATHIAZOL TABLETS OR SULFADIASINE	1. All wounds 2. All cocci infection: gonorrhoea, pneumonia, bronchitis, sore-eyes 3. Dysentery and diarrhoea	Wounds: 8 tab. with wa- ter at one time, if wound is serious. For cocci: 1 tab. 6 times a day. For XXXXX dysentery: 1 tab. 4 times a day. <i>To give 1 tab. 4 times with water</i>
CARBARBONUM CAPSULE	Dysentery and diarrhoea	One capsule 2 or 3 times a day
ASPIRINE TABLETS	Headache, joint pain and fevers	one tablet 3 or 4 times a day
QUININE TABLETS	Fever, cold, malaria	One to two tablets 3 times a day
SULFACQUAMIDINE POWDER	Dysentery and diarrhoea	2 paper 3 or 4 times a day
SODIUM BICARBONATE	Acidity, gastritis, indigestion	One to two tablets after meals.
TINCTURE OF IODINE	Antiseptic for wounds	For local application
GENTIAN VIOLET 2%	Ulcers of the mouth & tongue	
	Antiseptic for wounds	For local application
VALNOLIC ACID 10%	Ring worms or itches	For local application only
