- 3. Messengers etc.-carrying Outposts and GPs must, from a set distance and before effecting it, shout the pass word for the day until recognized whence he will approach.
- 2. In remote listening posts like Binas, Lesak etc. where no civilian is expected to roam around, any suspicious figure must be fired upon after 2000 hours.
- 1. Effective 1800 1700 May 45, the following PASS WORDS shall be observed within the A-Bn. Area during the period indicated opposite each set of pass words.
