To : All Battery Commanders

1. In order to attain a complete and exact training of the men, as based upon the weekly schedules, all Battery Commanders and Section Chiefs their attention is hereby invited to supervise and enforce the training schedule.

2. Avoid idleness in the part of officers and enlisted men under your command and instead in every spare hours teach or instruct them of all cases not covered by instruction, which is deemed important for example Reveille exercises, Max Plain Soldier Instruction from Group 1 - 3 ."

3. Battery Commanders when leaving his Office or Officers and NCOs shall notify Officers designated or his 1/sgt., their whereabouts. He Shall all times check his records, pending cases, and he must see to it that proper action will be taken immediately.

4. Supervise and instruct your Mess Officers and Mess and Supply Sergeants to give vital food for the men, and see to it that there are some reserves just in case of any emergency occurrence.

5. Inspectors could determine how to grade Officers by means of the rating the men under them .

6. Gain the confidence and complete cooperation of your Officers and men will extend the full swing of our Organization.
