This waybill must be legibly filled out by the dispatching office to include a full description of the mail, showing origin and address in full of each bag entered hereon.

One copy of the bill must be retained by dispatching office, one copy to be handed to the person to whom the mail is delivered for transportation, the stub of which is to be signed by him and retained by the dispatching office, and one copy to be inclosed with the mail for signature of the person receiving the same at the office of destination.

The receiving officer will fill out, sign, detach, and return the stub to office of origin, retaining the body of the bill as a record.

Should the mail be damaged, a full report shall be forwarded with the waybill to the Director of Posts. The stub receipt is to be so noted, signed, and promptly returned to office of origin.


