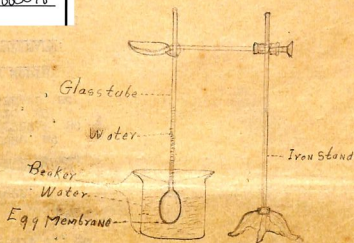

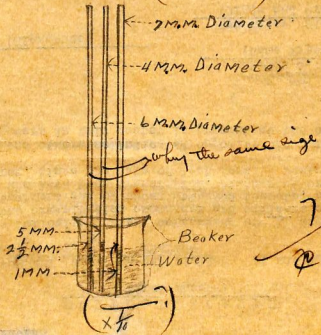

Be it enacted by the National Assembly of the Philippines:
