SUBMISSION OF INCOME TAX RETURNS

To Division Superintendents:

1. A Circular Letter of the Deputy Collector of Internal Revenue, dated January 24, 1940, regarding the filing of income tax returns, is hereby quoted for the information of all concerned:

I have the honor to forward to you, under separate cover, blank forms of the income tax return for individuals (B. I. R. Form No. 17.01), with the request that every officer and employee in that Office who received a gross income of P1,000 or more during the year 1939 be furnished with two copies of the form. The income tax return must be filed in duplicate.

The phrase "gross income" includes salaries, wages, bonus, or compensation for personal and professional services, profits and gains from business, trade, commerce, sales or dealings in personal or real property, and also income from interest, rents, dividends, securities or the transaction of any business carried on for gain or profit, or gains or profits derived from any source whatever.

Married persons are required to file one return only, declaring therein the combined income of the spouses. Where it is impracticable for the spouses to file one consolidated return, each spouse may file his separate return of income, but the returns filed by both spouses shall be consolidated for the purposes of the income tax. All the income tax returns of persons residing in the City of Manila must reach the Office of the Collector of Internal Revenue, and in the provinces and cities that of the Provincial Treasurers or their deputies and City Treasurers, on or before March 1, 1940.

In this connection, it is further informed that the obligation to file an income tax return is separate and distinct from the obligation to pay the tax, inasmuch as the law requires that a return shall be filed by every citizen or resident of these Islands who has a gross income of P1,000 or over, for the taxable year, although the return may show no tax liability on account of the deductions and exemptions provided for by the Income Tax Law.

2. Employees residing in the City of Manila may secure their copies of B. I. R. Form No. 17.01 direct from the Bureau of Internal Revenue where the returns are to be filed, and those in the provinces and other cities from the offices of the Provincial Treasurers or their deputies and City Treasurers.

VACATION COURSES IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION

To Division Superintendents:

1. In order to meet the need for in-service training in physical education for teachers, the Bureau of Education will conduct courses in physical education at the Rizal Memorial Stadium, Manila, during the long vacation this year. These courses will begin on April 15 and end on May 18. They should be helpful to teachers who are in charge of physical education in their schools and who may some day be appointed full-time physical education instructors.
2. The following courses will be offered:

a. Administration and Supervision of Physical Education	2:00 - 3:00
b. Gynnastics	3:00 - 4:00
c. Natural and Folk Dances	4:00 - 5:30
d. Coaching Methods	
(1) Baseball and Indoor Baseball	4:00 - 5:30
(2) Track and Field	3:00 - 4:30
(3) Basketball	4:00 - 5:30
(4) Soccer Football	5:00 - 6:00
(5) Swimming	2:00 - 3:00
(6) Combative Sports	
Boxing }	4:30 - 5:30
Wrestling }	

3. The courses will be free of charge. Teachers in the Bureau of Education who have an interest and an aptitude in physical education and who are recommended by their superintendents may enroll. Physical directors in private schools or private clubs will also be admitted, if recommended by the P.A.A.F. office.
4. The personnel of the Department of Physical Education, Bureau of Education, with the assistance of Dr. Regino R. Ylanan, National Physical Director, and his assistants, will serve as instructors. Through the courtesy of the P.A.A.F., teachers enrolled in any of the physical education courses may use the tennis courts free of charge in the mornings and the swimming pool free of charge any time of the day. The collection of books on physical education of the P.A.A.F. and of the Bureau of Education will be available in the P.A.A.F. library.
5. Male teachers who enroll will be given free quarters at the Track and Football Stadium. Beds and bedding will be furnished by the P.A.A.F., but the teachers will be held responsible for them and for the laundry of the bedding. A caterer who usually furnishes food at the rate of P1.20 a day for the athletes invited by the P.A.A.F. will furnish food at the same rate to the teachers enrolled. The house of this caterer is close to the stadium and will be convenient for the teachers.
6. The names of all teachers who plan to enroll in any of the courses listed in paragraph 2 should be reported to this Office on B. E. Form 37 on or before March 16.

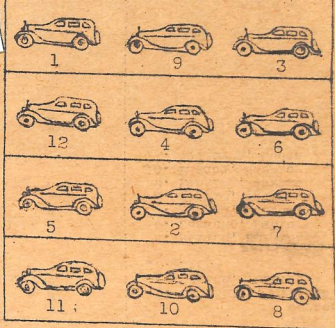

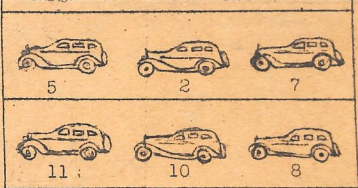

By a vote of 33 to 2 the following resolution was passed by the convention:

That the question of plain sewing in Grade I should be left in each case to the discretion of the respective division superintendents; that division superintendents be authorized to begin plain sewing in any one of Grades IA, IB, and II, because the work in Grade I is purely educational in any case. If plain sewing is not taught in Grade I, the course in hard and soft strips should be substituted.

Technical Bulletin No. 56 has now been issued outlining the new course in plain sewing. It is based upon the above resolution. In this technical bulletin there is also outlined the plans for supplying perforated patterns of all garments and for printing the revised Bulletin No. 53.

With respect to the elimination of shop work in fourth grades special attention is invited to the fact that the course in bamboo-rattan furniture may be substituted for the regular course in shop work at the discretion of the division superintendent.

By a vote of 22 to 15 the following resolution was passed by the Superintendents' Convention:

That a period of industrial work in embroidery or lace, or both, be introduced in high schools at the discretion of the division superintendent, such period to be supplementary and, if introduced, to be obligatory and credit to be given.

Two double periods per week in lace, embroidery, cooking, or housekeeping may be introduced into secondary schools in divisions where normal courses have not already been established and where teachers are being selected primarily from the secondary schools.

No industrial courses are being recommended for boys in view of the requirement for military training as prescribed in General Instructions No. 22, s. 1917.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE CUTTING OF TINDALO,
AKLE, OR MOLAVE TREES, UNDER CERTAIN CONDI-
TIONS, AND TO PENALIZE VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of
Representatives of the Philippines in
Legislature assembled and by the author-
ity of the same:

SECTION 1. The cutting in the public
forests of tindalo, akle, or molave trees
less than sixty centimeters in diameter
measured at a height of four feet from the
ground (breast high) is hereby prohibited.

SEC. 2. Any person, company, or cor-
poration violating the provisions of this
Act shall be punished by a fine of not more
than fifty pesos or imprisonment for not
more than fifteen days, or both, and to pay,
besides, two times the amount of the tax on
the timber cut; PROVIDED, That in the case
of a company or corporation, the president,
or manager shall be directly responsible
for the acts of his employees or laborers
if it is proven that the latter acted with
his knowledge; otherwise the responsibility
will extend only as far as fine is concerned;
PROVIDED FURTHER; That all tindalo, akle or
molave timber cut in violation of this Act
shall be forfeited to the Government.

SEC. 3. All acts and provisions of law
