PROVINCE OF CEBU.

S i r s:-

It has been brought to the knowledge of this office, through the quarterly report of inspection of municipal police rendered by the Provincial Commander to the Executive Bureau, that in several municipalities policemen are not properly clad as they are given only one pair of uniform.

In view of this fact, it may not be amiss to remind that garment is one of the necessary elements that enhance the respectability of persons constituted in authority, thereby paving the way for the better enforcement of laws and ordinances, while violation of public decorum by appearing before the public eye slovenly dressed, or in any way not properly clothed, instead of commanding the respect of the people, cause the functionary to be pitied if not to be held in derision, to the detriment of the prestige of officialdom. Hence my being compelled to urge those of you to whom the remark applies to take immediate steps looking toward equipping the municipal police with sufficient number of uniform, at least two pairs of uniform.



"In this connection, I must needs bring to your attention the fact that many of the crop and livestock reports submitted by these municipal presidents contain so many inaccuracies due to clerical errors or mistakes of fact and omissions that an enormous amount of correspondence becomes necessary between this office and various municipal governments to get such inaccuracies corrected.

Surely it is now high time for each and every municipal president to realize that he is measuring the wealth of the country, writing the history of his town; and that this work is worth doing more carefully. Moreover, the information a president submits is the basis of the agricultural statistics that this office prepares and then distributes far and wide - all over the world - to be used by governmental institutions and by commercial and industrial concerns. Fortunes in money are risked in enterprises which have been engaged in after studying statistics and thus it behooves every municipal president to be more reliable in his statements, for his own credit and the credit of the country.

These officials should make a list of all farms in their respective municipalities showing the names and addresses of the actual occupants, the total area of the farms and the actual area under cultivation for each crop. This work could be done in the same manner as that employed in enumerating, by barrios and by owners,
