

CHAPTER 4

THE OWNERSHIP OF RUNNING WATERS; SPRINGS, AND STREAMS.

ART. 33.--The following are public or of public ownership:

1. The waters springing continuously or intermittently from lands on the public domain.
2. The waters of rivers.
3. The continuous or intermittent waters of springs and creeks running through their natural channels.

ART. 34.--The waters springing continuously or intermittently from lands of private individuals, or from those belonging to the State, or to the provinces, or pueblos, belong, while passing there-over, to the respective owners of such lands for their use and enjoyment.

Unused waters flowing from the estate of their source become public property for the effects of this law when they run through naturally-formed public channels. But if, after leaving such estate and before reaching the public channels, they run through another estate of private ownership, the proprietor thereof may make contingent use of said waters, and after him, the proprietor immediately below, if there be any, and so on successively, but subject to the provisions of paragraph 2 of Art. 40.

These contingent enjoyment may be interrupted by the owner of the estate where the water rises using the water himself, even though those lower down the stream have used it for a longer time than a year and a day, or may have constructed works for its better enjoyment. The owner of the estate where the water rises shall lose his right to cause such interruption only when one or more of those below him shall have acquired a right under the provisions of Art. 39, or where the provisions of paragraph 1 of Art. 42 are applicable.

ART. 35.--The waters not used by the owners of the estate of their source become public property for the effects of this law when they run through naturally-formed public channels. But if, after leaving such estate and before reaching the public channels, they run through another estate of private ownership, the proprietor thereof may make contingent use of said waters, and after him, the proprietor immediately below, if there be any, and so on) as well as the residue after such use, shall leave the estate at the exact point of their natural and accustomed channel, and shall not be in any way deflected from the course by which they originally flowed away. The same holds in regard to the estate immediately below respecting the one that follows, and so on in order.

ART. 36.--Waters which, after running through a public channel, come naturally to cross an estate of private ownership, assume until they leave said estate the character specified in the two preceding articles in regard to their contingent use.

ART. 37.--The owners of estates situated below may freely carry out any plans necessary for the contingent enjoyment of the waters of springs and creeks in their natural channels, provided that they do not use any other banking materials than earth and loose stone, and that the quantity of water consumed by each of them does not exceed ten liters per second.

INTRINSIC AIDS IN STATUTORY CONSTRUCTION.

I. Nature of intrinsic aids.

- A. Those aids taken from the statute itself in determining the meaning and intention of the legislature. Those aids resorted to for the interpretation of the statute, where it is read and construed as a whole; its various parts compared; each doubtful word or phrase read in the light of the context; the interpretation clause, if there be any, examined to see if it defines or explains the ambiguous part; preamble, the headings of the chapters and sections and even the punctuations.

II. The intrinsic aids usually resorted to.

- A. The context or the language surrounding and accompanying the various sections, clauses and provisions of statute, as well as the particular words and phrases employed.
 - 1. Sections, clauses, and provisions of a statute, as well as the particular words and phrases employed, are not to be considered in themselves alone and construed as if isolated from the rest, but they are to be interpreted with reference to the language surrounding and accompanying them--the context; and if there is any ambiguity or doubt as to their intended meaning, the context must be consulted as a means of removing the obscurity.

Art. 93.--In such an event, each one shall contribute toward the cost according to the benefits he is to derive.

Art. 94.--In order to arrive at the wishes of the parties interested, or of the community, they shall all be called together before the "Alcaide" of the "Pueblo" where the works are to be constructed, or before some person designated by the Governor of the Province, where several "pueblos" are interested.

If a majority of those present, computed on the basis established in the next preceding article, are in accord, they shall appoint at once, and by a plurality of votes, a committee, whose duty it shall be to apportion the expenses according to the benefit to be derived by the property contributing, and afterwards to proceed with the collection of the funds.

Art. 95.--The works shall be executed in the manner preferred by the community, and shall be carried out under the direction of an engineer, under the active supervision of the committee in charge of the collection and disbursement of contributions, which committee shall render a strict account to the parties by whom it was appointed.

Any person regarding themselves as in any way injured by the resolutions or acts of the committee, shall have a right of appeal to the Governor of the province, who shall exercise over all the acts of the community that supreme supervision proper to his office.

Art. 96.--Whenever it may be necessary, in urgent cases, to construct, on estates of any kind, temporary works or to destroy existing ones in order to prevent or check threatened inundations, the local administrative authorities may, upon their own responsibilities, order the immediate execution of such work; but with the understanding that no loss or damage occasioned shall afterwards receive compensation, with five per centum interest annually, from the day on which the damage was done until the indemnity is paid. The party responsible for the payment of this indemnity shall be the State, the Municipality, or the private person or persons, respectively, depending upon the proprietorship of the objects threatened by the inundation and whose protection has given rise to the damage to be indemnified.

Art. 97.--The local works constructed under the above provisions for the defense of towns or villages, or of the country roads of a municipal district, shall be in charge of the respective municipalities and shall be in charge of the respective municipalities and shall be paid for by them.

The cost of works of general utility necessary for the protection against inundations of roads, public establishments, and valuable lands, or to keep free and clear the channels or rivers navigable by boats or rafts, shall be borne by the state.

Art. 98.--When as a result of works undertaken by the State or by "Pueblos," riparian properties are also benefited or augmented, the owners thereof shall, collectively, contribute the proportional part agreed upon between them and the State or the Municipality. The individual quota of each person interested shall be fixed by an expert named by each party, with a third in every case of disagreement, according to common law.

ART. 37.--They shall be obliged, ohnly, to give notice to the "vicarios" of the "pueblo" for the information of the governor of thá province.

If in the course of a creek, and before its incorporation into a river, there should exist some estate crossed by the stream, its owner shall be preferred in the use of the water over riparian owners whose lands abut on the channel. If the stream does not cross any estate the owners of the lands adjacent to the channel be entitled in regular order to the enjoyment of the water rights granted above in Art. 41.

It is to be understood that no contingent enjoyment of water rights may interrupt of interfere with those previously acquired in the same waters in a lower region.

ART. 38.--Waters discovered in the zone of operations of the Department of Public Works, although carried out by concessioners, belong to the State, unless it has been otherwise stipulated in the conditions of the concessions.

They shall, however enjoy their gratuitous use in the construction of the said works.

The overflow waters from fountains, sewers, and public establishments belong to the respective "pueblos".

ART. 39.--The right to enjoy in perpetuity the waters of springs and creeks is acquired by the owners of lower estates, and in the same way by those of adjoining estates when they have appropriated said waters without interruption for a space of twenty years.

ART. 40.--If the owner of an estate upon which a natural spring rises does not use more than one-half, one-third, or some other fractional part of its waters, the remainder or residue becomes subject to the conditions of Art. 34 regarding uses by lower estates.

When the owner of an estate upon which a natural spring rises, does not make use of more than a fractional, though determinate, part of its waters, he shall, at times of decrease or diminution in the volume thereof, continue to use and enjoy the same absolute quantity of water as before, and the loss or shrinkage shall be suffered by the irrigators or beneficiaries lower down, whatever may be their titles to the enjoyment of the waters.

ART. 41.--If the owner of an estate from which natural waters spring, allows twenty years to pass by after the promulgation of this law without making use of them, appropriating them neither in whole nor in part in any way whatever he shall lose all right to interrupt any use or enjoyment of the same waters exercised for a space of a year and a day continuously by estates situated lower down the stream.

In consequence of the above provisions, estates situated below, and in the same way those situated laterally, acquire in the order of their location, the option to use the water in question and consolidate their title thereto by uninterrupted use.

But it is to be understood that in the case of those lower or lateral estates, the one which shall enjoy, or shall have enjoyed, any waters with a priority of one year and one day, cannot thereafter be deprived of the same by another, even though such other be situated higher up on the stream.

Art. 152.--....When the steepness of the ground or other obstacles so require, the tow-path shall be opened at the most convenient point.

Art. 153.--The Government shall, upon making the classification of navigable and floatable rivers, determine the breadth of the tow-path and the bank of the river along which it shall run.

Art. 154.--In the case of rivers newly declared navigable or floatable, proper compensation shall be made before the tow-path is opened, in accordance with the provisions of the law regarding compulsory expropriation.

Art. 155.--When a navigable or floatable river permanently ceases to be so, the easement of tow-path shall also cease.

Art. 156.--Tow-path shall be used exclusively for the service of the navigation and flotation of rivers.

Art. 157.--Navigation canals are not entitled to a tow-path but if the need of such should arise, this easement may be imposed under the law of compulsory expropriation.

Art. 158.--No planting, sowing, fencing, or ditching shall be done on the tow-path, nor any other works which might impede its use. The owner of the land may, however, make exclusive use of the shrubs and plants growing naturally upon said path.

Art. 159.--Branches of trees which interfere with navigation or flotation, or obstruct the tow-path, shall be lopped off as high up as may be necessary.

Art. 160.--Riparian estates are subject to an easement permitting the mooring or fastening of the necessary ropes or cables for the establishment of ferry boats, after compensation for loss or damage.

Art. 161.--The creation of this easement in favor of ferry boats shall pertain to the governor of the province, whom shall first ~~grant~~ bearing to the owners of the lands to be burdened.

Art. 162.--If it should be necessary, in order to prevent lumber being floating down a stream from being swept away by a flood to take it out of the water and deposit it upon the riparian estate, the owners of such estates shall not impede it, and shall be entitled only to compensation for any loss or damage. The lumber in question shall be specially liable for the payment of this compensation, and shall not be removed until the carriers shall have made the payment due or given bond.

Art. 163.--The owners of riparian estates are also obliged by law to permit the deposit thereon of merchandise unloaded or saved in case of distress, wreck, or other urgent need, said merchandise being held liable for the satisfaction of any loss or damage resulting, in accordance with the terms of the next preceding article.
