Sir:

I have the honor to furnish you herewith for your
information and guidance, a copy of Provincial Auditors'
Memorandum No. 154 prohibiting local purchase of supplies
and materials requiring scientific or technical tests,
except when the amount involved in ₱100.00 or less.

x x x x x x x x x x

In the attached memorandum, local purchases may be
allowed when the value is ₱100 or less. Under Prov. Div.
Cir. No. 505, such local purchases of ₱100 or less may
be done by price canvassing. So as to properly place
responsibility in the matter of price canvassing, it is
also requested that the office making the requisition may
conduct such price canvassing under supervision of your
property section. In the audit of vouchers for local
purchases of supplies of ₱100 or less, hereafter this
Office will require statement from the official concerned
to the effect that price canvassing has been conducted and
that the store or firm to whom the purchase is being made
offers the most advantageous price to the government.

It is also informed in connection with the ₱100 or
less in value of limitation, that purchases for the same
kind of materials even within the ₱100 or less in value

MEMORANDUM (Unnumbered)

June 17, 1941

TO ALL MUNICIPAL TREASURERS:
Province of Leyte

The following letter of the Department of Finance is transcribed hereunder for the information and guidance of, and compliance by, all concerned:

May 16, 1941

"S i r :

"For your information and immediate appropriate action, there is quoted hereunder Executive Order No. 339, current series, of the President of the Philippines, requiring all government entities to purchase a reserve supply of oil products for possible emergency use:

'Upon recommendation of the National Emergency Commission and pursuant to the authority vested in me by Commonwealth Act No. 600, I, MANUEL L. QUEZON, President of the Philippines, do hereby direct that the following regulations be observed by all departments, bureaus, offices, agencies, and instrumentalities of the Government in purchasing oil products for use in case of a possible emergency:

'1. All government entities shall immediately provide for at least a 4-month reserve supply of gasoline, lubricating oil, grease, kerosene and diesel oil which can be readily accomplished by requisitioning these supplies in tin cans and storing them at safe and convenient places. In the case of oil products for lighthouses, a one year reserve supply shall be acquired and properly stored.

'2. In addition to providing a 4-month reserve supply of the above mentioned oil products, all government entities concerned shall continue to purchase such oil products as are necessary to meet their current requirements and hold their reserve supply until an actual emergency occurs or no new supplies can
