1. The Commanding Officer, "G" Co., 96th Infantry reported that on the night of March 16, 1945, HUGO ARACAP, a member of the Japanese Constabulary detained by the said unit escaped and took with him the following things belonging to the "G" Company:

- 2 No. German Luggers
- 3 Pcs. Fatigue pants
- 1 No. Army blanket woolen
- 4 " Fountain Pens
- 1 " Carbine US cal. 30
- 4 " Magazine for US Carbine
- 1 " Pouch magazine for US Carbine

2. It is presumed that HUGO ARACAP must have taken a banca for Bohol as there were bancas from Bohol which left Talosno on the following day.

3. HUGO ARACAP is a resident of Sevilla, Bohol.
