ACCRUED AND VACATION LEAVE

To Division Superintendents:

The following is taken from Bureau of Civil Service Circular 7, dated March 22, 1923, and is quoted for the information and guidance of all concerned:

Act No. 3087, which went into effect on March 16, 1923, provides that regularly and permanently appointed officers or employees, including operators, messengers, detectives and secret agents, are entitled to 18 days' vacation and 24 days' accrued leave yearly. For the information and guidance of the parties concerned, it should be stated that in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 2 b of Civil Service Rule 16, messengers who were permanently and regularly appointed prior to January 1, 1923, are entitled to 17½ days' vacation leave for this year; those persons who were formerly entitled to 21 days' annual vacation leave are entitled to 18½ days' vacation leave for this year; and those who were formerly entitled to 28 days' annual vacation leave may be given 20 days' vacation leave for this year.

Sec. 1-a of Civil Service Rule 16 prescribes that where the absence is chargeable against the accrued leave application for accrued leave on Civil Service Form 39 must be used. It is therefore requested that any absence in excess of the vacation leave allowable be covered by application for accrued leave, thus obviating the necessity on the part of this office to explain in each individual case why a portion of the leave applied for has been charged against accrued leave.

This office requests that the contents of this Circular be brought to the attention of all concerned and that in forwarding applications the foregoing facts be had in mind.

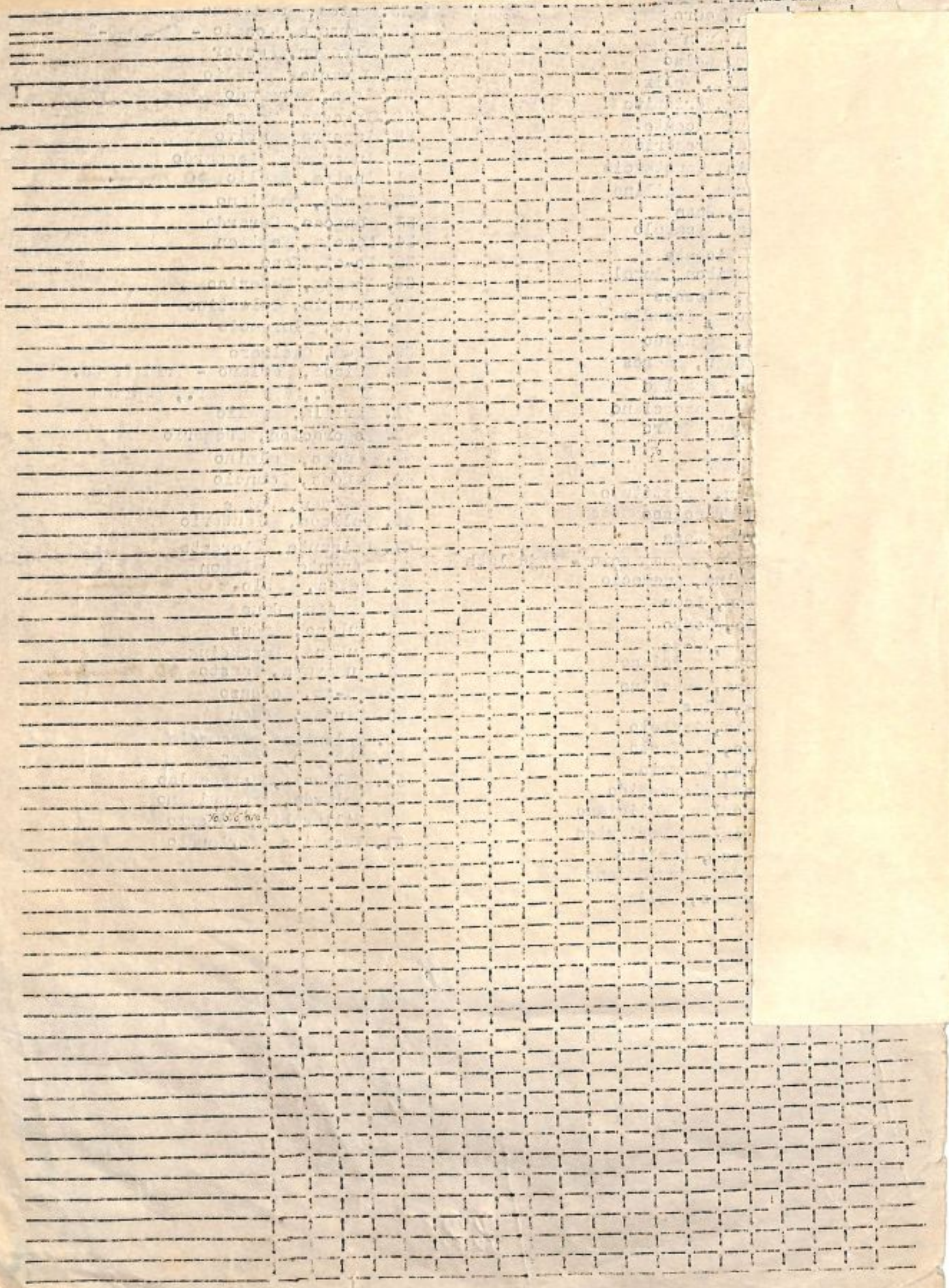

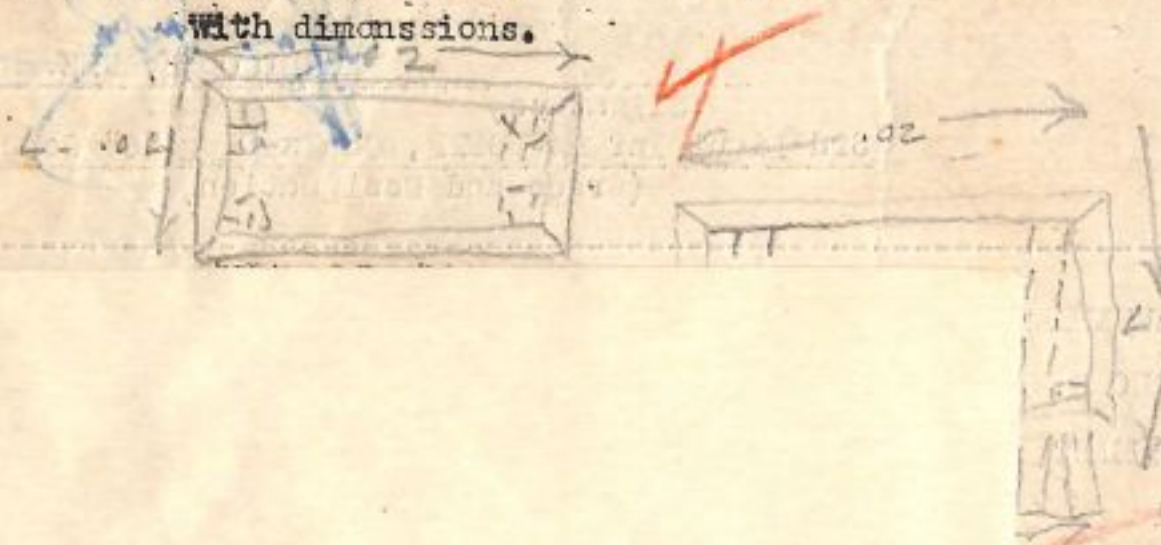

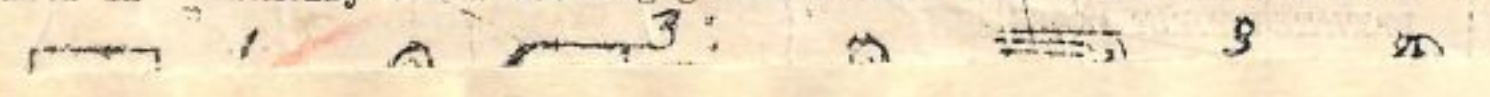

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO THE TEACHER EXAMINATION

To Division Superintendents:

The Bureau of Civil Service announces that effective July 1, 1930, the following will be the requirements for admission to the TEACHER examination:

1. Graduation from a four-year course in a college or university of recognized standing with the degree of Bachelor of Science in Education;
2. Graduation from a normal school with at least two years of work on a college level; or
3. Graduation from a four-year course in a college or university of recognized standing with a degree such as A. B., M. A., Ph. B., B. S., B. S. C., etc., and credit of at least 18 units of professional subjects as follows:

History of Education	3 units
Principles of Teaching	3 "
Principles of Secondary Education	3 "
Educational Psychology	3 "
Educational Sociology	3 "
Any one of the following	3 "
a. The teaching of English in secondary schools	
b. The teaching of Economics	
c. The teaching of History	
d. The teaching of Mathematics	
e. The teaching of Physics	
f. The teaching of General Science	
g. The teaching of Biology	

Substitution of any other educational subjects for any of the above (a, b, c, d, e, f, or g) may be made at the discretion of the Director of Civil Service.



FOR: All Chiefs of Divisions, Sections, Offices, Units and other officers and employees

SUBJECT: Complaints or requests for service through the telephone

1. Upon receipt of any complaint through the telephone by any division, section, office or unit of the Bureau of Health on account of insanitary condition, nuisances, etc., or telephone request for any service, the division, office, or unit receiving the call shall record in a book duly kept for the purpose, the following:

The party calling shall be told that he will be called back about his complaint or request, or, if the said party has no telephone, he shall be advised to call again, after giving sufficient time to repeat such call. The information obtained shall then be transmitted to the corresponding unit or section charged with the service desired, requesting that the matter be attended to, and, in case it cannot be effected at once, information should be secured when it can be attended, giving the day and hour, if possible. If the party concerned has a telephone, the number of which was previously secured, the information as to when the service requested could be rendered shall be transmitted by the office that was originally called. The division, office, or section rendering the service shall, after completion of the service required, again call the section or office that originally received the complaint or request for the service desired, notifying that such service has been duly rendered. For this purpose, on the same line where the data to be entered in the book as stated above has been recorded, the following shall also be made to appear:

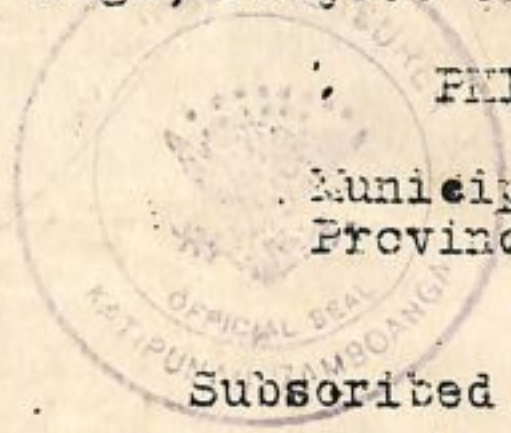

Administration shall advise the proper departments, bureaus, offices, subdivisions, agencies, or instrumentalities of the Government from time to time as to the unemployment situation in the different localities in the Philippines, and it shall be the duty of these departments, bureaus, offices and other dependencies of the Government to get their supply of laborers from the list furnished by the National Social Security Administration, with a view to giving employment, as far as practicable, to those in need of aid in public works and land settlement projects and other works carried out by any branch or agency of the government. He shall further seek to enlist the cooperation of private employers in the distribution of employment in such manner as to provide the maximum amount of relief from unemployment.

The National Social Security Administration shall also take and keep a census of the indigents, who are physically incapacitated for work, in the Philippines and shall from time to time advise the Bureau of Public Welfare of the necessary aid that should be extended to the said indigents.

Executive Order No. 139, dated January 14, 1938, as amended by Executive Order No. 188, dated February 23, 1939, Executive Order No. 197, dated March 24, 1939, and Executive Order No. 216, dated July 28, 1939, and all other orders which are inconsistent herewith are hereby revoked. Provided, That until the members of the National Security Board are appointed and qualified, the present National Relief Board shall continue performing its functions as heretofore.

Done at the City of Manila, this 19th day of August in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and forty, and of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, the fifth.
